Dear Parents Guardians,

Following some queries regarding teaching groups and the new house system, we would like to clarify how pupils are grouped during the day.

Year 5	House groups for morning register, assembly and Tutor time. E.g. 5 IsaacNewton/Newton AND for lessons EXCEPT maths and English where they are set by ability.
Year 6	House groups for morning register, assembly and Tutor time. E.g. 6IsaacNewton/Newton. Teaching groups (6STEDML) for lessons EXCEPT maths and English where they are set by ability. For Creative Studies lessons, pupils are taught in a mix of form groups eg S and T.
Year 7	House groups for morning register, assembly and Tutor time. E.g. 7FlorenceNightingale/Nightingale Teaching groups (7STEDML) for lessons EXCEPT maths and English where they are set by ability. For Creative Studies lessons, pupils are taught in a mix of form groups eg S and T.
Year 8	House groups for morning register, assembly and Tutor time. E.g. 8EdwardElgar/Elgar Teaching groups (8STEDML) for lessons EXCEPT maths and English where they are set by ability. For Creative Studies lessons, pupils are taught in a mix of form groups eg S and T.

'Home learning' for English and maths is set on the same night for all pupils within a year group. For Year 7 and Year 8 pupils other subjects, such as history and science, set their home learning tasks during one of the lessons of the week. This is to ensure that home learning tasks are spread out over the week. Teachers will let pupils know when tasks are due in and will endeavour to give more than one night for completion of the task.
