Luggage

1 medium sized suitcase plus label and a medium sized bag for packed lunches, drinks, etc. for the journey. **IMPORTANT: NO MOBILE 'PHONES OR ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT PLEASE.** Puzzle books and card games are ideal. Pupils may bring a disposable camera.

Food and Drink

This is a very long journey and children will need enough food and drink to keep them going until they arrive at the centre. A three-course cooked meal will be provided at the centre in the evening. For the return journey, breakfast and a packed lunch will be provided. We will stop at the services on the way down and back and children may purchase food if they wish.

Pupils will make their food choices for the week (for lunch and dinner) prior to departure. We encourage pupils to make their own decisions and try new foods. The Youth Hostel offers menus that cater to vegetarian and gluten free diets. There is a choice of 2 main courses for dinner along with jacket potatoes with cheese/beans etc. Breakfast is cooked breakfast, cereals, toast and dinner includes options such as sausages and mash, pie and mash, pizza and lasagne. Lunch includes 5 sandwich choices with brown or white bread, crisps, a snack and a piece of fruit.

Clothes

Please make sure your child has the following:

1 waterproof garment, e.g. anorak or cagoule with hood

1 strong pair of walking shoes or trainers

Working materials

Each child will need a pen, pencil, ruler, rubber and coloured pencils. Sketchbooks will be provided.

Medicines

All medicines must be handed to the group leader labelled with name and instructions. Asthma sufferers must carry their usual inhalers and provide a spare for the medical box. Suncream and travel sickness pills may be carried by the children themselves.
