## **Annual Governance Statement for St Edward's Church of England Academy** **2024-2025**

In accordance with the Government's requirement for all Trustee Boards, the 3 core strategic functions of our Board of Trustees are:

- **Strategic leadership of the academy** – to define the vision for high-quality and inclusive education for all our pupils
- **Accountability and assurance** – to have robust effective oversight of the operations and performance of the Academy including:
  - The provision of education
  - Pupil welfare
  - Overseeing and ensuring appropriate use of funding
  - Effective financial performance
  - Keeping the premises and grounds safe and well maintained
- **Engagement** – to have strategic oversight of relationships with stakeholders, involving parents/carers, local schools and the local community so that our decision-making is supported by meaningful engagement

Our instrument of governance is comprised of the following categories:

- 2 Parent Trustees
- 8 Foundation Trustees
- The Principal

The Board of Trustees meets at least once each term. We also have committees to consider different aspects of the Academy in detail and other committees to carry out statutory functions. During 2024-2025 these committees will be:

- Audit Risk and Finance
- Quality of Education

The work that the Board has completed during last year (2023-24) includes:

- Appointment of a new Vice Principal for pupil welfare and safeguarding
- Strategic oversight of Talent Enhancement (Performance Management)
- Academy budget monitoring
- Pupil Premium /Sports Premium monitoring

- Safeguarding monitoring and quality assurance
- Health and Safety issues and building works monitoring
- Scheduled policies and procedures updated and reviewed
- Staff recruitment/staff allocation monitoring
- Curriculum review – intent, implementation and impact monitored to ensure pupils develop their learning
- Data analysed to ensure that pupils make good progress from their starting points
- Attendance monitored and tracked
- Discussions with SLT, middle leaders and teachers

Our Board of Trustees Action Plan for 2024-2025 hopes to achieve the following:

- Support the Academy to improve educational outcomes for all pupils
- Continue to develop an Academy curriculum that meets all of our pupils' needs
- Further develop Trustee training (including our induction programme) and continue robust self-assessment
- Develop and monitor the Academy Development Plan strategically in line with the Academy Risk Register
- Carry out regular monitoring that links directly to the Academy Development Plan and the improvement of the Academy
